- Dave and Busters Date and Hours: May 19, 2016, 11:00 pm May 20, 2016, 6:00 am.
- Project Graduation is for the 2016 Altha High School Graduates only; no friends, siblings, other relatives, spouses
 or children of graduates are allowed. Only parents or legal guardians of the graduates may attend if they pay the
 entry fee.
- Altha High School Project Graduation 2016 is free for all eligible graduating seniors that have participated in at least one project graduation event. Only those seniors actually graduating are eligible.
- Seniors must be present at the end of the celebration to claim any and all prizes won. Prizes will not be given out until 5:00 AM or after. In order to be eligible for any prizes (gifts items or cash), the senior and/or family member representing the senior must participated in at least half of the project graduation events. (Example: If eight (8) events are planned, scheduled and completed then participation must be in at least four (4) of the events.)
- Graduates are to sign in before they get on the buses and leave at 10 pm; we will not admit anyone after midnight.
- All graduates are to enter and exit through the front entrance only.
- Parents will be called if a graduate leaves before 6:00 am, or if they do not show up and are registered to attend. If a graduate leaves the building (other than with an escort), he/she will not be allowed to re-enter.
- All graduates *must* be registered in advance in order to attend. No graduate will be admitted who has not turned in a permission form by the designated deadline.
- Absolutely no drugs, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, or weapons of any type are allowed; parents and authorities will be notified in these events.
- No outside food or beverages are permitted.
- Any uncooperative behavior or argumentative behavior will not be tolerated; graduates exhibiting such behavior
 or violating this contract in any way will be asked to leave (and parents called).
- Signed permission slips must be turned in *no later than Friday, December 18, 2015.* A parent must sign even if a student is 18 years old.
- All chaperones have complete authority to enforce the above rules.
- Upon arrival, graduates will not be permitted to leave the building temporarily unless under escort.
- Understand and acknowledge that by engaging in the activities, an element of risk is involved, and that accordingly, and in consideration for being permitted to participate, the undersigned agrees to indemnify and hold hosts, including all vendors, Dave and Busters in Pier Park, Panama City, host schools, school district and/or the organization harmless from any liability for personal injury or property damage caused by participation in the activity and from any and all costs incurred, including, but not limited to attorney's fees that hosts may suffer by any action or claim brought against it by anyone as a result of the use of such facility. The undersigned also gives permission for the graduate's image to be used in any promotional segment/piece that may be filmed or taped at this event.
- Photographs or videotapes of the attendees may be used in future Project Graduation promotional materials.
